## World Stroke Day | October 29, 2015

WHEREAS, stroke is the second leading cause of death worldwide and fourth leading cause of death in the United States, and is a leading debilitating health problem; and

WHEREAS, Global Stroke Resource, also known as Bcenter, is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization headquartered in Winter Park with a mission to empower, educate and facilitate recovery for stroke survivors and their families; and

WHEREAS, Global Stroke Resource and its founder, stroke survivor and Orlando native Valerie Greene, is dedicated to empowering stroke survivors worldwide and serves as a leader for World Stroke Day, which was established by the World Stroke Organization in 2006 to increase public awareness of the high stroke risk and stroke prevalence worldwide; and

WHEREAS, approximately 85 percent of all strokes, also known as brain attacks, can be prevented with lifesaving knowledge of risk factors and symptoms, paired with proper lifestyle choices; and

WHEREAS, a headache is the most common symptom of stroke, while many may also experience slurred speech, numbness or weakness, confusion, dizziness or blurred vision; and

WHEREAS, stroke can happen to anyone, including children and babies in utero, but age, heredity, race and gender can increase risk factors; and

WHEREAS, World Stroke Day is an opportunity to empower residents in our community and worldwide to learn how to prevent and/or recover from stroke.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Steve Leary, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Winter Park, in the state of Florida, do hereby proclaim the day of Thursday, October 29, 2015, as World Stroke Day in the City of Winter Park, Florida.
